Polisi Gwisg Ysgol

School Uniform Policy

Ionawr/January 2011

Mae'r wisg ysgol yn rhan o hunaniaeth yr ysgol; dylai gael ei gwisgo yn ôl y rheolau isod tra bod disgyblion yn teithio i'r ysgol, adref o'r ysgol ac o fewn yr ysgol.

Cynlluniwyd y wisg ysgol i fod yn rhad i'w brynu ac yn syml heb achosi gwrthdaro.

Disgwylir i bob disgybl gydymffurfio â'r wisg ysgol.

Gwisg Ysgol (i fechgyn a merched oni bai nodwyd yn wahanol)

- Crys polo glaswyrdd gyda logo'r ysgol wedi ei frodio arno*
- Crys chwys llwyd gwddf rownd(arddull "Blue Max") gyda logo'r ysgol wedi ei frodio arno*
- Trowsus neu sgert ddu. Rhaid i hyd y sgert fod i'r ben-glin. Disgwylir i'r trowsus a'r sgert fod yn synhwyrol ac o'r fath fydd yn dderbyniol i wisgo mewn swydd broffesiynol mewn swyddfa. Ni chaniateir trowsus wedi fflerio, trowsus sy'n rhy hir, jîns, trowsus melfed, melfaréd, trowsus tyn na throwsus sgïo neu trowsys arddull "combat". Argymhellir bod rhieni'n cysylltu â'r ysgol cyn prynu os yn aneglur.
- Gyda throwsus: sanau du, llwyd tywyll neu glas tywyll
- Gyda sgert: teits trwchus du neu sanau $\frac{3}{4}$
- Esgidiau du synhwyrol. Dim sodlau uchel na sandalau. Ni chaniateir gwisgo trainers. Rhaid i ddisgyblion wisgo esgidiau ar bob achlysur yn ystod y dydd oni bai bod anghenion gwisg ar gyfer cwricwlwm yr ysgol yn gofyn am anghenion gwahanol.
- Cot law du, glas tywyll neu lwyd tywyll gydag adlewyrchyddion arnynt (opsiynol). Ni chaniateir logos mawr (e.e. mwy na 8cm x 8cm) ar y got ysgol. Ni chaniateir "hoodies".
- Caniateir sgarffiau, hetiau a menig o unrhyw liw i'w gwisgo i'r ysgol ond rhaid i ddisgyblion eu tynnu ymaith pan gyrhaeddant yr ysgol.
- Ar gyfer achlysuron arbennig/cyngherddau ayb: crys gwyn gyda llewys hir a thei ysgol. Gellir prynu'r tei o'r ysgol.
- Rhaid i arddulliau gwallt fod yn synhwyrol ac o'r fath sy'n dderbyniol mewn sefyllfa gwaith swyddfa broffesiynol. Dylai'r lliw fod yn naturiol a ni chaniateir bandiau o liw/iau gwahanol. Ni ddylai'r arddulliau fod yn eithafol a ni ddylid cael amrywiaethau annaturiol mewn lliw gwallt sydd â'r effaith o dynnu sylw at y disgybl. Argymhellir yn gryf fod rhieni'n cysylltu â'r ysgol cyn bod disgybl yn cael ei (g)wallt wedi ei drin mewn ffordd a ystyrir yn wahanol.
- Rhaid i ddisgyblion sydd â gwallt hir ei ffasno nol mewn labordai, ystafelloedd lle gwneir gwaith ymarferol ac ar gyfer Addysg Gorfforol.

Colur

Ni chaniateir i ddisgyblion wisgo colur yn yr ysgol. Anfonir disgyblion y tybir eu bod yn gwisgo colur i'r swyddfa i'w dynnu ymaith.

Tlysau a Gemwaith

Ni chaniateir unrhyw dlysau na gemwaith o unrhyw fath heblaw am oriawr. Os yw disgybl yn gwisgo tlysau fe'i cymerir oddi arno/i a'u cadw nes diwedd y dydd. Os yw disgybl yn parhau i wisgo tlysau wedi hyn, cymerir y tlysau oddi arno/i a'u cadw dan glo yn swyddfa'r ysgol nes i riant anfon llythyr i'r ysgol i ofyn i'r eitemau cael eu dychwelyd.

Mae'r ysgol yn parchu bod rhai amodau crefyddol neu feddygol pan fo angen i ddisgyblion wisgo eitem gemwaith. Er mwyn i hyn ddigwydd bydd angen i'r ysgol dderbyn cais ysgrifenedig swyddogol gan offeiriad yng nghrefydd y disgybl i'r disgybl wisgo; r eitem gemwaith. Mewn achosion meddygol, bydd angen llythyr swyddogol gan Feddyg neu nyrs gysylltiadol y plenty, yn nodi'r rhesymau pam ddylai'r plentyn wisgo'r eitem.

Wedi hyn, bydd angen cytundeb clir ynglŷn ag amodau gwisgo'r eitem gemwaith o flaen llaw cyn bod y disgybl yn gwisgo'r eitem yn yr ysgol.

Nid yw'r ysgol yn gallu cymryd cyfrifoldeb dros unrhyw eitemau gemwaith a wisgwyd gan ddisgyblion.

Gwisg Addysg Gorfforol

- Crys rygbi cildroadwy gwyrdd/du arbenigol*
- Crys-t gyda logo'r ysgol wedi ei frodio arno*
- Siorts du
- Esgidiau rygbi/pêl droed/"trainers" (yn ôl yr angen)
- Trowsus tracwisg du (opsiynol ar gyfer tywydd oer yn unig)

**Dynodir hyn eitemau arbenigol gellir eu prynu'n unig o'r darparwyr gwisg ysgol.*

Os oes unrhyw amheuaeth a yw eitem gwisg yn cydymffurfio â'r rheolau uchod neu os oes unrhyw gwestiynau gennych ynglŷn â'r wisg, gofynnir i rieni gysylltu â'r Arweinydd Cynnydd ar gyfer ei phlentyn er mwyn trafod materion ymhellach.

Rôl disgyblion

Disgwylir i ddisgyblion gydymffurfio â'r rheolau gwisg. Os yw disgybl yn torri rheol gwisg heb fod nodyn o'r rhieni, bydd yn cael ei gosbi yn unol â pholisi disgyblaeth yr ysgol.

Rôl athrawon

Disgwylir i athrawon fonitro gwisg disgyblion yn ystod sesiynau cofrestri, gwersi a chyfnodau eraill. Dylid rhoi gwybod i Diwtor Personol neu Bennaeth Cynnydd a Lles os yw disgybl yn torri rheol gwisg ysgol.

Rôl rhieni

Cynlluniwyd y wisg fel ei fod yn syml ac yn rhad i'w brynu. Disgwylir i ddisgyblion gydymffurfio â'r wisg ar bob achlysur. Os oes unrhyw anawsterau gyda darparu'r wisg, dylid cysylltu â'r ysgol.

Dyddiad dilysu gan y Llywodraethwyr: Ionawr 27, 2011

The uniform is part of the school's identity; it should be worn according to the following rules whilst pupils are in school or are travelling to and from school.

The uniform has been designed to be inexpensive to purchase and non-confrontational.

All pupils are expected to wear the school uniform.

School uniform (applies to both boys and girls, unless otherwise specified)

- Turquoise polo shirt with embroidered school logo.*
- Grey sweatshirt with round neck ("Blue Max" style) with embroidered school logo.*
- Black trousers or black skirt. Skirts must be knee-length. The trousers and skirt must be sensible and of the nature of clothing that would be deemed acceptable in professional office based employment. Flared trousers, overly long trousers, jeans, velvet or corduroy trousers are not allowed as are tight trousers or ski pants or combat style trousers. If unclear, parents are advised to check with the school before any purchases are made.
- With trousers: black, dark grey or dark blue socks.
- With skirts: thick black tights or $\frac{3}{4}$ socks.
- Sensible black shoes. No high heels or sandals. Trainers are not allowed. Pupils must wear shoes on all occasions during the school day unless clothing requirements for the school curriculum dictate otherwise.
- Black, dark blue or dark grey rain coat with optional reflectors. Large logos (e.g. greater than 8cm x 8cm) are not allowed on the school coat.
- Scarves, hats and gloves of any colour are allowed to be worn to school but pupils must remove them when they arrive at school.
- For special occasions/concerts etc: white long-sleeved shirt with school tie. The school tie can be purchased from the school.
- Hairstyles must be sensible and of the type which are acceptable in a professional office environments. The colour should be natural and bands of different colour(s) are not allowed. There should be no extreme hairstyles or unnatural variations in the colour of hair which have the effect of drawing attention to the pupil. It is strongly recommended that parents contact the school before a pupil has their hair styled in a manner which may be considered different.
- Pupils with long hair must fasten it back in laboratories, for practical work and for Physical Education.

Make-up

Pupils are not allowed to wear make-up in school. Pupils that are believed to be wearing make-up are sent to the office to remove it.

No jewellery of any type is allowed besides a watch. If a pupil is wearing any jewellery it will be confiscated and kept until the end of the day. If a pupil continues to wear jewellery after this first incident, the item(s) will be confiscated and stored securely in the school office until a parent writes a letter to the school requesting that the items are returned.

The school respects that there are some religious or medical reasons when pupils are required to wear jewellery. In order for this to happen the school requires an official written request from a priest (or equivalent) from the religion of the pupil in order that the pupil will be allowed to wear the jewellery item. For issues of a medical nature, an official letter from the child's GP or attached nurse will be required, indicating the medical reason for the child to wear the item in question.

Following this, a clear agreement beforehand will be required in relation to the conditions under which the jewellery item will be worn prior to the pupil wearing the jewellery item in school.

The school cannot accept responsibility for any items of jewellery worn by pupils.

Physical Education Uniform

- Reversible green/black rugby shirt*
- White t-shirt with school logo.
- Black shorts
- Rugby/football boots or trainers (as required)
- Optional black tracksuit bottoms (for cold weather use only)

* These denote specialist items that can only be purchased from the specialist school uniform suppliers.

If there are any uncertainties as to whether an item of clothing conforms to the above rules or if there are any queries in relation to the uniform, parents are requested to contact their son/daughter's Head of Progress and Guidance in order to discuss matters further.

Pupils' Responsibilities

Pupils are expected to conform to the uniform rules. If a pupil breaks a uniform rule without written authorisation from a parent, the pupil will be punished according to the school's discipline policy.

Teachers' Responsibilities

Teachers are expected to monitor pupil uniform during registration, lessons and any other periods. The pupil's Personal Tutor or Head of Progress and Guidance needs to be informed if a pupil is in breach of school uniform rules.

Parents' Responsibilities

The uniform was designed to be simple and inexpensive. Pupils are expected to conform to the uniform requirements on all occasions. If there are any problems with being able to adhere to uniform rules, please contact the school.
