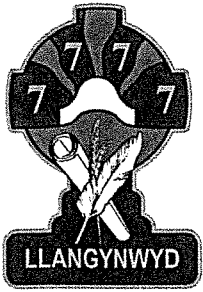

RE: Year 10 Science GCSE examinations

I am writing to let you know that your son/daughter will very shortly be sitting external examinations in Science.

The dates of the exams are as follows:

14th June - Biology
16th June - Chemistry,
19th June - Physics.

These exams are very important as, in total, they will contribute towards 45% of the final mark they receive in each of the Science subjects. Therefore it is vital that all pupils prepare thoroughly for each exam if they are to achieve a C grade or better.

We have been preparing for these exams for a number of weeks in school and the pupils have recently taken mock exams as part of their preparation. Although most pupils performed quite well, there is still room for improvement.

I am sure that you are eager, as we are, for your son/daughter to be successful in these exams. We would therefore be grateful if you could encourage and support your child so that they use the time remaining to prepare thoroughly. This could involve doing things such as helping them to prepare a realistic revision timetable and keeping to it or testing their understanding of a particular topic. We would expect your son/daughter to spend at least an hour every evening revising a topic. This should involve taking concise revision notes, learning key facts from memory, practicing exam questions etc.
