Cydymdeimlwn yn ddwys â'i theulu a'i ffrindiau ar yr adeg anodd iawn hwn.

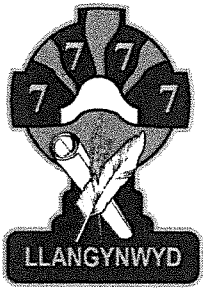

Dear Parents/ Guardians

It is with great sadness that I write to inform you that we received the tragic news of the death of one of our pupils Kelsey-Lee Sheldon, over the weekend due to natural causes linked to asthma.

Such tragic news has, of course, come as a great shock to us all and our thoughts and sympathy go out to Kelsey's family and friends. The loss has had a huge effect on us as a school, but I am confident that we will all pull together to support one another through this difficult time.

We have told the pupils that we will do all we can to support them, guided by staff from Bridgend educational psychology service. As well as our own staff, trained counsellors have been present at school today offering pupils an opportunity to talk or express their feelings in other ways. We will continue to be available for the pupils to talk and ask questions and we will make areas available for them at school for this.

Any pupils who would like to write a message will be invited to do so in a book of condolence over the next few days.

We will keep to our usual school routine as far as possible in order to provide the pupils with stability and you as parents are also very welcome to contact us if we can support you.
